We've taken notable strides since our last newsletter. The number of recipients of the Home & Dry Starter Grant are now into double figures, with 90% of those young beneficiaries doing well in their original accommodation; and 100% currently living in a place they can call their own.

The feedback we've been getting from our partner, Framework, has been very encouraging. The Home & Dry Starter Grant is a hugely welcome benefit for young people facing homelessness, providing them with funds for a deposit, enabling them to secure safe and independent accommodation.

Spurred on by our success with Framework, we look forward to building on our relationship with them, and hope we can strike up similar partnerships with organisations across Nottinghamshire, with the aim of helping more deserving young people.

We recognise the success of our charity is entirely dependent on forging the right partnerships with organisations who are coming into contact with homeless young people on a regular basis. We believe they are best placed to make the right judgement call when it comes to identifying those young people working hard to get back on their feet, who would derive long term benefit from a leg up, in the form of a Home & Dry Starter Grant.
