Hello to partners and friends, old and new. With your help, we've made considerable progress since we last wrote.

We've cemented a new partnership with Broxtowe Youth Homelessness and we're delighted to have now helped over 20 young people in Nottinghamshire, with our Starter Grants.

How do we help?

Home & Dry recognise the difficulties young, disadvantaged people face, when trying to secure safe, independent accommodation. Specifically those that can afford to pay rent, but can't fund a deposit.

On the recommendation of our Partners, we can swiftly come to the help of these youngsters, by funding their deposit with a Home & Dry Starter Grant.

A word from our latest partner

In the same week we enabled our 20th young person to find a home of their own, we were delighted to welcome Broxtowe Youth Homelessness (BYH) as our newest Partner. We rely on trusted Partners to evaluate the suitability of nominated individuals. In return, we aim to help all suitable nominations as quickly as is practical.



It was good to hear first hand, that our aims matched the experience of Jessica Brannan, Project Manager at BYH: "When we made our first referral to Home and Dry, they were true to what they had promised. The process was very quick and the deposit was provided within 24 hours of us making the application. This allowed us to very quickly house a pregnant young woman in need and start work to help her settle into her property, preparing for the arrival of her baby."

Jessica continued: "We hope to be able to make more referrals in the future and we will continue to tell other organisations about the good work Home and Dry is doing. Thank you for providing this much needed service and removing one of the many barriers our young people face to accessing housing."
