From inception, Home & Dry's aim has always been to work in partnership with organisations and charities experienced in delivering housing care and services to young people. Our approach is to pragmatically work together with experts on the ground. We take our lead from them to provide a Home & Dry Starter Grant, in the form of a rental deposit; to assist young people they've highlighted as being ready, but financially unable to take their next step towards securing independent accommodation. We hugely value and rely on the input of our partners to identify these youngsters. Without them, it would not be possible for us to deliver what we do.



Home & Dry are proud and grateful to work with Framework, Broxtowe Youth Homelessness and René House, who between them have helped us award 43 Starter Grants. We're now delighted to welcome NPRAS, our newest partner, who've assisted us in taking that total to 45. To give them their full title, the Nottingham Private Rented Assistance Scheme helps support those who are homeless, or at risk of homelessness, to secure long-term, affordable, good quality accommodation. All our partners are likeminded and we all share the same goal of achieving effective housing outcomes for young people. We all believe that with a little help, a lot of positive things can happen.
