It's good to work with the YMCA

We're delighted to have received our first referral from the YMCA Robin Hood Group. They provide temporary supported accommodation to vulnerable young people across Nottinghamshire and the East Riding. Many of their service users suffer from a variety of issues, including homelessness and mental wellbeing, struggling to live independently. They empower their service users, by providing them with the tools to become the best versions of themselves and to ultimately live independently.

Grant Davies, Housing Manager, YMCA Robin Hood Group commented: "It is extremely difficult for many of our service users to move into their own independent accommodation. Most of the individuals we support lack the funding required to source private accommodation and are often prevented from living independently. The Home & Dry scheme is a much-needed source of funding, recently helping an individual we support access their own independent rented property. They're now thriving in their own home and feel positive about their future. We're extremely grateful for the support of Home & Dry and look forward to working in close partnership with them, to support our service users accessing the funding they need, as they move towards independent living."
